| <p>A) Personal data shall be processed for the following purposes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - creation of a data base containing statistical and sports information concerning soccer players, referees, members of federations or associations, with the simultaneous creation of the relevant profiles on the WYSCOUT Professional Platform, an international soccer platform including data, statistics, videos and tools for game preparation. The platform is also a good tool for the discovery of new talents and train and promote soccer players; - provision of a technical analysis service concerning sports events, with a painstaking analysis of sports activities of data subjects (players and referees) and performances, creating statistical analyses on the basis of known personal data (taken from public sources, usually the internet, or in any case readily available via web, videos and newspapers). Data are summarised in professional soccer players’ cards and referees’ cards. - promotion and development of soccer world, including clubs and individual players, providing technical analyses services of sports events, videos productions, educational activities, match analysis , data analysis and scouting. | <p>Data processing shall be performed in compliance with the lawfulness conditions of art. 6 par. 1 letter f) of Regulation EU 2016/679: - with reference to the user’s account, for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data, in particular where the data subject can reasonably expect at the time and in the context of the collection of the personal data that processing for that purpose may take place (recital 47 GDPR).</p> <p>The legitimate interest is motivated by the immediacy of the player/referee performance evaluation, the precision in the technical assessment; - benefits also for the relevant party (awareness of their technical performance), for the services offered; the beneficiaries are not only the relevant parties but also Clubs, Football Leagues, Federations, Confederations, Agents, Sports agents and, in general, all professionals working in the soccer sector.</p> | <p>Data shall be processed automatically and manually, in a manner and with tools that ensure maximum security and confidentiality, by specifically appointed subjects. In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 par. 1 lett. e) of Regulation EU 2016/679, the collected personal data shall be kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed. In particular, personal data shall be processed for no longer than is necessary, as detailed in Recital 39 of the Regulation EU 2016/679, without prejudice for an additional retention period that can be that can be required by law, as also provided for in recital 65 Regulation EU 2016/679. With regard to Processing activities carried out, please remember that it is always possible to object to the processing at any time. DATA RECIPIENTS OR RECIPIENTS CATEGORIES</p> <p>Personal data will be communicated to subjects who will process the data as processors (art. 28 of Regulation EU 2016/679) and / or as natural persons acting under the authority of the Data Controller and Data Processor (art. 29 of Regulation EU 2016/679), for the purposes listed above in paragraph 3, and to third parties. More specifically, data will be communicated to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the relevant data subjects but also Clubs, Football Leagues, Federations, Confederations, Agents, Sports agents and, in general, all professionals working in the soccer sector; - companies controlled by, controlling or under the joint control of Wyscout or its associated companies; - service providers specifically identified and authorised by Wyscout or other subjects with whom Wyscout executed co-operation agreements with regard to the Platform or the services provided through the platform; - subjects providing management services for the computer system and communication networks (including email); - firms or companies within the context of assistance and consultancy relationships; - competent authorities to fulfil legal obligations and/or provisions of public bodies, on request. <p>Subjects belonging to the abovementioned categories carry out processing activities acting as Data Processors, or operate in a completely autonomous way, as independent Data Controllers. DATA TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRIES</p> <p>A transfer of personal data to European Union and non-European Union Countries can occur in order to fulfil any of the connected purposes mentioned above. Data shall be transferred in compliance with article 44 and following of Regulation EU 2016/679, only on the basis of an adequacy assessment or subject to appropriate safeguards. |  | <p>6. AUTOMATED PROCESS</p> <p>There is no automated decision-making. Data subjects are not subject to decisions made exclusively on the basis of the automated data processing, including profiling, and which produces legal effects concerning them or which significantly affects them in a similar way.</p> |

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS</p> <p>Data subjects have the right to obtain access to their personal data and their rectification (including in case of erroneous data) or erasure, as well as the restriction of their processing, or to object to their processing (articles 15 and following of Regulation EU 2016/679). Data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint to the Data Protection Authority. Moreover, data subjects have the right to the portability of their personal data and, in this case, the Data Controller shall provide them with their personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. Data subjects have the right to erasure (right to be forgotten) of their personal data or data subjects can object to their processing on the basis of a legitimate interest.
